Just peg a few pages in the family-holiday album for some snaps of an unforgettable experience while you're there: whale-watching from above! **A TENT TO REMEMBER** A family of four or five will have a splendid stay in one of five Luxury Tents overlooking a peaceful dam. Each tent has its own fireplace, private deck, fully equipped

kitchen, hot-water shower, and two comfy queen-sized beds, one of which has an inviting single bunk bed – there's no roughing it here! The Tasting Room on the estate is the go-to breakfast and lunch spot for young families, as there's a sandpit, trampoline and jungle gym for the kids to play on, while the adults catch up over a delicious cappuccino. **THE X FACTOR** Hermanus, a mere 30 minutes from Stanford, has been recognised by the World Wildlife Fund as one of the 12 best whale-watching

destinations in the world. Catch a glimpse of these gentle giants of the sea in a novel way – from above, on a scenic 30-minute flight in a small three-seater aircraft, which departs right from the estate's own airfield. The best time to try a whale-watching air safari? Plan that exciting trip for some time between June and December. **COST?** Air safari from R3 500 per flight.
